He chose us in Him before the foundation of the world Eph 1:4 NASU


Predestined – What is written in the book

Transparent – nothing to hide, no pretending

Authentic – OK to be themselves, not hidden, double-minded

Loving, intuitive, prophetic – Help others find what's in their hearts

Courageous – know their personal calling

Connected......Double-minded (heart vs mind).....multiple personalities

- 1. What we say and do comes from our heart, not our minds (computer that justifies)
- 2. Language of our hearts is experience (not knowledge)
- 3. Hearts are changed by experiences (not information)
- 4. We know people by knowing hearts, not what they say

## Matt 16:15-19



## Connected means:


- 1. Authentic just trying to be myself instead of someone else

## Acts 27:42-28:6

The soldiers planned to kill the prisoners to prevent any of them from swimming away and escaping. 43 But the centurion wanted to spare Paul's life and kept them from carrying out their plan. He ordered those who could swim to jump overboard first and get to land. 44 The rest were to get there on planks or on pieces of the ship. In this way everyone reached land in safety.

28 Once safely on shore, we found out that the island was called Malta. 2 The islanders showed us unusual kindness.
