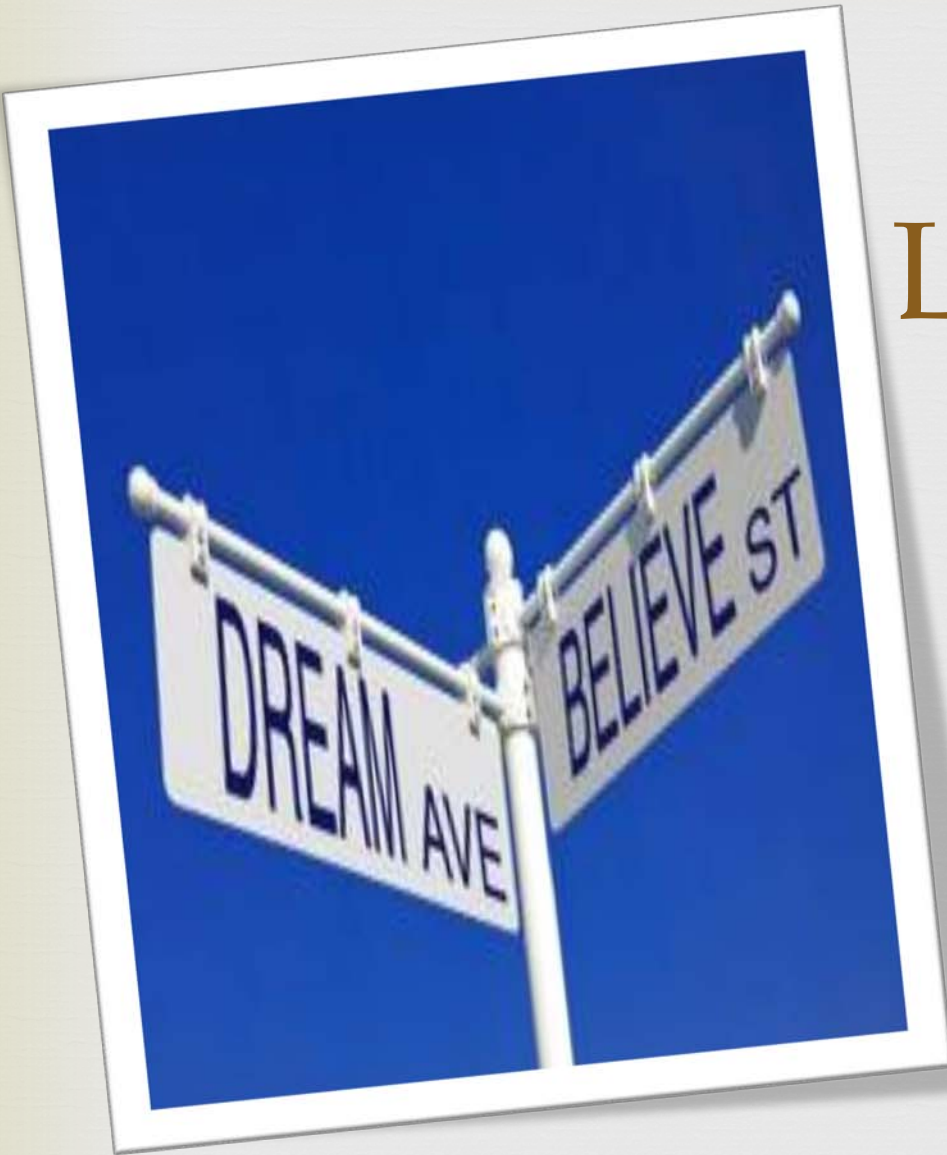

- c. believe that there isn't going to be anything more to life

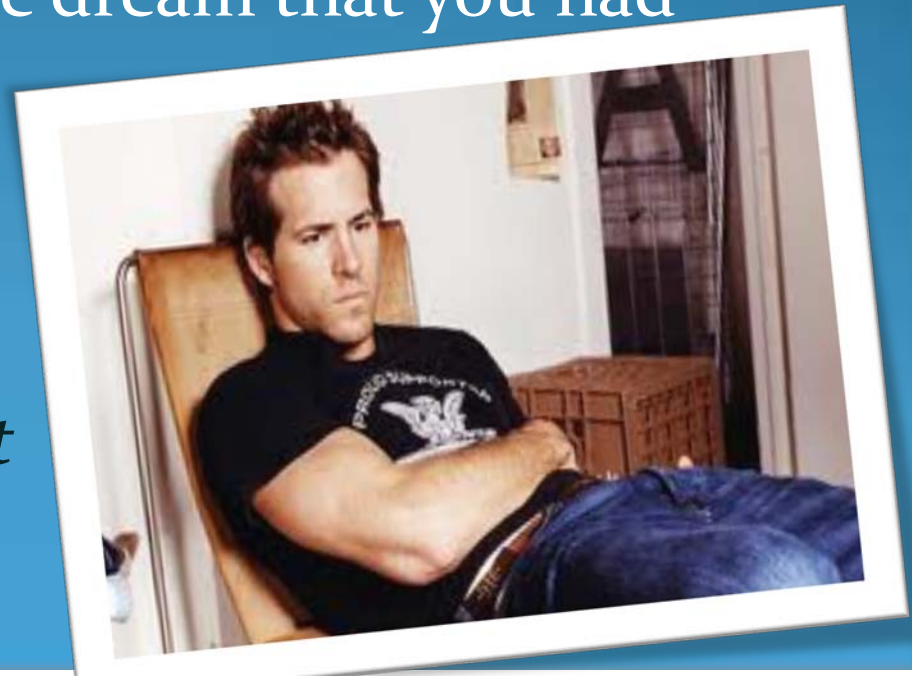


*Average people take the stance
