

Creating a Place Where Business Leaders Engage with the Church

Have you ever wondered how to get more of the successful business and political leaders to actively engage to do “What the Father is doing?” Or have you seen some of your key leaders and potential leaders being drawn more and more into the newly emerging avenues of Coaching and Mentoring, etc. in the secular world and wondered what the church’s role should be? Or have you been seeking God so that you might be on the leading edge of the new sound coming from heaven and are hearing a sound of marketplace ministry? If so, Releasing Kings might just be the answer you are looking for.

There is a huge Kingdom emphasis regarding marketplace ministry right now. Business men and women are being invited to co-labor with Jesus in reaching our cities and nations. Our books, newsletters and conferences communicate a message that resonates with the entrepreneurial calling in both believers and those outside the church. In our business conference in Warsaw (November 2010) we saw 30 business men and women saved in a business conference... we simply invited them into the Kingdom and placed strategic value on their businesses and financial skills.

This year we’ve developed a coaching module that provides a forum for communicating the message on a more personal level. After our conferences, people are ignited to put the message to work in their own lives and share it with others. In Warsaw, a Polish coach has started a business that touches 2-4 people every week in an [8 step coaching process](#) that releases their hearts, takes their business to the next level and connects them with the local church. We’re connecting the desires God put in the heart’s of His people with His will via things like vision and goals all the way to cash flow and a business plan. We are not just changing hearts but we’re teaching God’s people to create wealth and turn money into ministry to build the Kingdom.

So how does this help the pastor and the local church? Our next goal is to build a bridge from business coaching to a “user friendly” version for local churches. Our vision is to help pastors implement a coaching platform to make disciples who can do business, create wealth, and convert money into ministry in a way that impacts our culture. We’re seeking local churches to work with us to use relational business coaching to equip the saints to build the Kingdom beyond the four walls of the church.

These are the specific resources we have to help business people connect with the Kingdom. We want to feature local churches that model this same process to equip saints with an entrepreneurial calling. We believe that creating wealth is one additional spiritual discipline that enables our ministry in the marketplace. 1. Purpose and Vision – Write down your life purpose. Why are you here? What is the activity that reflects the deepest desires of your heart, your core character values, the area of your personal passion, and your talents, skills and abilities? Why does God want to prosper you? Write it down in a paragraph.

2. Goals – With your life’s purpose in mind, what are your goals for the major areas of your life (God, family, vocation / ministry, finances, health, and play)? Write them down in the past tense.

3. Heart Boundaries – Most of us have boundaries in our hearts that represent vows from our past which have cemented into ceilings for our future. Changing the beliefs in our hearts about our own identity and potential is a key step of inner healing before we can go to the next level.

4. Affirmations – If we set some lofty goal associated with our life purpose, our mind immediately starts coming up with a list of reasons why it won’t work. If we simply phrase our “affirmations” as questions, we can then meditate on the reasons “why” those things will come to pass. These “affirmations” give our mind a constructive job that builds us up and gives our heart the answer it seeks regarding “why.”
