Giving Your Heart Reasons to Worship

See Experiencing Praise

We **worship** God when we understand who God is and the attributes he has. We express **thanksgiving** when we review the great things he has done in the past. **Praise** has its roots in understanding what God is about to do. I'm suggesting that it was no surprise that the Jericho walls fell, and no surprise that Paul and Silas got out of prison. Everybody knew what was coming!

I created a list of my 10 favorite aspects of God's nature. You can find a helpful and Biblical list of the names and attributes of God <u>here</u> that will help remind you of your favorite aspects of God's nature. For each of those 10 attributes I recalled the specific things God has done for me out of that specific attribute for which I'm thankful. I also listed the things God and I will yet do in the future for which I praise him in those same 10 categories of God's nature. It's a great exercise that helps me focus on all the heart reasons we have to worship, give thanks and praise Him. I'm giving my own heart some concrete reasons to worship, give thanks, and praise God.

Note: The future things I'm praising him for are my goals from the <u>coaching module</u>.

During my devotions,

- 1. I simply worship God for who He is around one of attributes in the left column
- 2. Then I move on to thanksgiving for a specific area where He has already done something great for me.
- 3. Next, I praise Him for the things he will do in the future in that same category. These items are really my goals from the coaching module.
