1) Give value; a reason to engage

- **Cause** – help them articulate their purpose
 - Help them slay their own giants (warfare)
 - Move from energy/spiritual/financial deficit to overflow
- **Contribution** – Help them plug into shared purpose
 - Networking biz opportunities, learning opportunities.
 - helping one another in biz, in the spirit.
 - Prophetically getting the goods and praying for one another on the phone.
- **Community** – Let them taste Ecclesia
 - How to instill Culture in their own group, team, staff

2) Articulate higher purpose.

- Daily – a lifestyle of doing what Father does (co-laboring, that releases power)
- Reformation – of People, Biz, Cities, Nation(s)
 - Jn 5:17 – "My Father is always at his work to this very day, and I too am working."*
 - 19) Jesus gave them this answer: "Very truly I tell you, the Son can do nothing by himself; he can do only what he sees his Father doing, because whatever the Father does the Son also does."*
 - 20) For the Father loves the Son and shows him all he does. Yes, and he will show him even greater works than these, so that you will be amazed.*

3) Experience Celebration of victories

- Part of Kingdom culture, it's worship.
- See Father's progress in Sons

4) Prepare your heart for many sons

- Make the template for growth; that doesn't feel like abandonment
- Make growth feel like love
- Welcoming new family members

Lord, What is on your heart? How do we make a home for the line of sons waiting for Kingdom?
What's your strategy?

Create the culture that incubates and disciples sons (Welcomes them!)

- Transparency vs religious fig leaves
- The religious Spirit in Business
 - 1) I'm good, or blessed, or mature, or have stature, because I make money.
 - 2) I'm (all of the above) because I help other's make money.
 - 3) I'm busy is the fig leaf that protects my heart from transparency (hiding from God) ...because I don't really have His Purpose; I just have this fig leaf!
- Fathers "seeing" who sons are; where they are going (clearly)
(Then stewarding them into their hearts... destiny)
- The culture is a garden
 - No pretense (fig leaves)
 - Conversations – what Father is saying can be heard
(Sons walking with Him in the cool of the day)

Jesus

We are redeeming sonship; the garden

- Pulling people into rest to be themselves.
- Pulling them into their hearts.
- Where there is seeing/Seers, vision, exploits, mighty men.
- Where the KPI is what God can do through you.
- Because Father's voice is heard, His purpose is known; and done.

I (Jesus) redeemed access to father for His sons. I am Jacob's ladder.

See the treasure in earthen vessels.

Holy Spirit

I have given you a trumpet to assemble Ezekiel's army of sons.

Make a clear sound.

1 Cor 14:8 – Again, if the trumpet does not sound a clear call, who will get ready for battle?

Num 10:8 – "The **sons** of Aaron, the priests, are to blow the trumpets.

This is to be a **lasting ordinance for you and the generations to come**.

9) When you go into battle in your own land against an enemy who is oppressing you, sound a blast on the trumpets.

Then you will be remembered by the LORD your God and rescued from your enemies.

10) Also at your times of rejoicing—your appointed festivals and New Moon feasts—you are to sound the trumpets over your burnt offerings and fellowship offerings, and they will be a memorial for you before your God. I am the LORD your God."

Josh 6:4 – Have seven priests carry trumpets of rams' horns in front of the ark. On the seventh day, march around the city seven times, with the priests blowing the trumpets.

5) When you hear them sound a long blast on the trumpets, have the whole army give a loud shout; then the wall of the city will collapse and the army will go up, everyone straight in."

Joel 2:1 – Blow the trumpet in Zion; sound the alarm on my holy hill.

Let all who live in the land tremble, for the day of the LORD is coming.

- The clarity of the trumpet sound is timely, prophetically correct.
- Verbalize what father is already speaking to sons.
 - What is already written in their hearts.
 - Call them into the rest of knowing Father goes before them.
 - Call them into being themselves, without fig leaves.
(additions, transformations, condemnation, competition)
 - Help them experience the difference.
 - Intellectual self-transformation; self-discipline; external accountability
 - Compared to walking with Father (co-laboring)
 - **Sons are changed as we walk with Him; not as a precondition**

Wisdom – strategy

Unconditional love is the disarming confrontation of “sonship.”

- The feeling of being invited, included in Father’s purpose.
- Co-laboring is proof to hearts that Father is real.
- It an experience that transforms daily.

Sons are transfigured in the Council (not just transformed by accountability)

- It’s intentional, but not intellectual.
- It’s experiential, not “required reading.”

Understanding – tactics

Lord, how to make transparency safe?

- My hard work has produced these full barns (safety, identity, self-sufficiency)

Mt 6:26 – *Look at the birds of the air; they do not sow or reap or store away in barns, and yet your heavenly Father feeds them. Are you not much more valuable than they?*

Lu 12:16 – *The ground of a certain rich man yielded an abundant harvest.*

18) *... I will tear down my barns and build bigger ones, and there I will store my surplus grain.*

19) *And I'll say to myself, "You have plenty of grain laid up for many years.*

Take life easy; eat, drink and be merry.

21) *This is how it will be with whoever stores up things for themselves but is not rich toward God."*

Kingdom – true riches are “Rich toward God”.

<u>Heart Experiences</u>	<u>Outward Metrics</u>
2Cor 6:8 – <i>through Gory and dishonor</i>	(Success)
<i>Bad report, and good report</i>	(Reputation)
<i>Genuine, yet regarded as imposters</i>	(Character)
9) <i>Known, yet regarded as unknown</i>	(Visibility)
<i>Dying, yet we love on</i>	(Vulnerability)
<i>Beaten, yet not killed</i>	(Safety)
<i>Sorrowful, yet always rejoicing</i>	(Happiness)
<i>Poor, yet making many rich</i>	(Wealth)
<i>Having nothing, yet possessing everything</i>	(Prosperity)

Mt 6:20 – *Store up for yourselves Treasures in Heaven, intentionally.*

- Sons are the treasures! ...in earthen vessels.
- Be in heaven, in your seat, in the Council.

Mk 10:21 – *"One thing you lack," he said.*

"Go, sell everything you have and give to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven. Then come, follow me."

Counsel

John, you tasted true wealth with Holly, Fred.

- Father has given you true wealth.
- The treasure is in the Council.
- It's you, Sons are Father's treasures in heaven.
- Sons are Father's treasure in earthen vessels.
- Treasure in Heaven are sons in the Council, in their seats.

See how many you can store in heaven!

Knowledge

Freedom from earthly treasures and measures

Feels like a bird out of the fowlers snare.

Ps 124:7 – *We have escaped like a bird from the fowler's snare;
the snare has been broken, and we have escaped.*

8) *Our help is in the name of the LORD, the Maker of heaven and earth.*

The goal is Rich Toward God in Kingdom Business

- Be intentional about storing treasures in heaven (sons)
- Kingdom is not a vow of poverty; it's a vow to prioritize Father's purpose.

Fear of the Lord

Value what Father values

- Righteousness – be on His page.
- See the genius of His priorities.
- Release His Power and Might via co-laboring
- Find where your heart overlaps with His, and do it from the heart
- Work in your *metron* is worship.
