Jesus

2 Cor 8:9 – *For you know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that though he was rich, yet for your sake he became poor, so that you by his poverty might become rich.*

Rev 3:18 – *I counsel you to buy from me gold refined by fire, so that you may be rich*

Mt 5:3 – *“Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.*

Mt 11:5 – *the poor have good news preached to them.*

Mt 19:21 – *give to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven; and come, follow me.*

2Cor 6:10 – *as poor, yet making many rich; as having nothing, yet possessing everything.*

Ja 2:5 – *has not God chosen those who are poor in the world to be rich in faith and heirs of the kingdom, which he has promised to those who love him?*

Holy Spirit

Prophecy the release of Riches toward God

- True Riches
- Treasures in Heaven

Rom 8:28 – *And we know that in all things God works for the good*

- *Of those who love Him*
- *Who have been called according to His purpose.*

If I had money, I would be able to _____ (do my own thing!)

- Quit work, travel, write, market, network

2Cor 9:8 – *God is able to make all grace abound to you, so that having all sufficiency in all things at all times, you may abound in every good work.*

Mk 10:29 – *there is no one who has left house or brothers or sisters or mother or father or children or lands, for my sake and for the gospel,*

- 30) *who will not receive a hundredfold now in this time, houses and brothers and sisters and mothers and children and lands, with persecutions, and in the age to come eternal life.*

John, I am allowing you to feel a longing for things in my heart.

- That money cannot satisfy
- It's a hunger for Kingdom purpose meaning, results, love, the movement, Reformation

Wisdom – strategy

Count your blessings (Ps 36:5-10)

Ps 36:5 – *Your steadfast love, O LORD, extends to the heavens, your faithfulness to the clouds.*

- 6) *Your righteousness is like the mountains of God; your judgments are like the great deep; man and beast you save, O LORD.*
- 7) *How precious is your steadfast love, O God! The children of mankind take refuge in the shadow of your wings.*
- 8) *They feast on the abundance of your house, and you give them drink from the river of your delights.*
- 9) *For with you is the fountain of life; in your light do we see light.*
- 10) *Oh, continue your steadfast love to those who know you, and your righteousness to the upright of heart!*

Col 3:1 – *Since, then, you have been raised with Christ, set your hearts on things above, where Christ is, seated at the right hand of God.*

- 2) *Set your minds on things above, not on earthly things.*

Sons see from father's perspective:

- They don't set their hearts on lack and evil.
- They are bright lights who always see Father making a way.

Understanding - tactics

John, fill your heart with:

- What is in Father's heart
- What He is doing.

Share the emotion, do the works. Be where you are, allow father to come in

Ps 24:7 – *Lift up your heads, O gates! And be lifted up, O ancient doors, that the King of glory may come in.*

8) *Who is this King of glory? The LORD, strong and mighty, the LORD, mighty in battle*

Lift up your head from discouragement

Counsel

John, I am keeping you in touch with the emotion of the poor.

- 1) I want to be a part, but I can't.
- 2) I am left behind over poverty and squandered opportunity.
- 3) I can see regret and obstacles, but I can't see the King of Glory coming in.

The answer is the Council – it's sonship!

John, nurture sonship in the Courts and Council

- It's Riches Toward God, don't hoard it
- Share it, the experience of it (Mt 4:4, it's every word that proceeds from Father)

Knowledge

Jesus was rich but became poor for our sake

- That we might have true riches
- Sonship, access to Father
- Access to his purpose and power, to co-labor.

Don't set your heart on the love of money (1Tim 6:10)

Set your heart on things above (Col 3:2)

- Make true riches your intentional goal
- Feed the poor in spirit (humble, hungry) so that they inherit the Kingdom (Mt 5:3)
- Fill those who hunger and thirst for Righteousness (on the same page, Mt 5:6)
- Live from every word Mt 4:4
- Let the rivers of living water flow your belly, Jn 7:38

Fear of the Lord

Honor what Father has given you

Mt 13:11 – knowledge of the secrets of the kingdom of heaven has been given to you, but not to them.

- 12) **Whoever has will be given more**, and they will have an abundance.
Whoever does not have, even what they have will be taken from them.

Know what you have been given already. Use it and you will be given more... multiply what you have.

Lu 16:11 – So if you have not been trustworthy in handling worldly wealth, who will trust you with true riches?
