

Father – Yahweh (Father)

Got this comment on a video clip I posted.

For me the message is always attractive (that’s why I stick around) but never enough. I’m looking for examples for every term you use. The terms you use are like big words that I find difficult to grasp the meaning of. Just a hint ... perhaps I’m not the only one who’s in this position. Purpose, process, heart, release. It’s like a new religious jargon used to those that have been growing up in hearing all this and now it is natural and enough. For me it is not...

Lord, teach me how to add the stories, examples

- How do I rewire to naturally talk about application?
- Paint the picture of accessible truth, accessible ascension “for everyone”
- I dwell on the theory, theology, process, truth (less on the experience, feeling, application)
- How to make it their truth, that sets them free?

It’s Faith + Works

- Faith – truth, living prophetic words from the Council
- Works – the applications of living words, the works to implement what Father is doing
- People learn by doing, not exhortations, preaching, sermons

Extraordinary innovation/creativity is accessible; make it so by:

- 1) Show them results they will get
 - a. Use the language of their results, fruit
 - b. Tell the stories, give the examples of where this truth leads.
 - c. That show how it’s done (How it gets results)
- 2) Explain why in term of results (Why it gets results)
- 3) Show how to execute ideas, make faith “work” for them (Faith without works is dead)
 - a. Have the 9 conversations
 - b. Ask the questions
 - c. Implement what you get (put it in writing, make the plan, do the work)

What Sons Bring Back to Business From 9 Conversations in the Council

God’s Council	Transformations from Conversations	God’s Answers
<i>Father</i> (I AM Yahweh)	→ Identity – The sense of being Chosen, having access to Father	Who Am I? Who is my Father?
<i>Jesus</i> (I AM Your Redeemer)	→ Story – Redeeming my past and leveraging it for the future	
<i>Holy Spirit</i> (I AM Bread, Truth)	→ Purpose – Knowing my role, Father’s brand, values, priorities	Why AM I Here? Father is doing now?
<i>Wisdom</i> (I AM the Light)	→ Strategy – I have a plan that implements our mission and vision	
<i>Understanding</i> (I AM the Door)	→ Tactics – I have a tactical advantage, Co-laboring with Father	
<i>Counsel</i> (I AM Good Shepherd)	→ Heritage – I know what Father has given me to own, develop	Where Am I Going? Things to come?
<i>Might</i> (I AM Resurrection Life)	→ Courage – It’s natural for me to be heroic, an overcomer	
<i>Knowledge</i> (I AM the Way)	→ Clarity – I can clearly articulate where I’m going and why	
<i>Fear of the Lord</i> (I AM I the Vine)	→ Culture – I see what people carry, Biz Ecclesia = shared purpose	

Jesus – Immanuel, God with us, Redeemer of (My Story)

Get the living words for their story, not just yours

- What is Father saying to them?
- What has he invited them to do?
- Redeem their “works” (How they apply their truth)
- Engage their imagination, Innovation, dream
- Engage them in creating the manifestation of their Purpose
- Teach them to ask the right questions, engage Father, Jesus, 7 Spirits

Holy Spirit – I AM the Bread of Life, Spirit of Truth (Purpose)

Turn the lights on the *how* – how to apply purpose

- Revelation of their purpose engages people in dreaming of how
 - Purpose is the root of creativity, innovation
- I’m seeing my purpose unfold “things to come”
- Seer gifting paints the picture (shows the future application)

John, liberate people to see; use their seer gift from the Council

- What manifestation of purpose looks like
- Put themselves in the future story of “things to come” = take the tour

Wisdom – I AM the Light of the world (Strategy)

I can turn the lights on (seer gift) and see the strategy to implement the Purpose

The goal is putting people in the scene of their own story

- “I see you _____”
- Pull them into their identity, story, purpose, strategy, tactics... etc.
- Help them see it

Understanding – I am the Door (Tactics)

Tell the stories you do have (steward them, wait for them)

Trust Father for testimonies, Exploits (Like Cees and Kamila)

- Treasure them, thank Father for them
- Watch for them
- Make room for Father to do His part (the miraculous)
- Invite the King of Glory in – open the gates of Heaven (Ps 24:7)

Counsel – I am the good Shepherd (Heritage)

John, you have been hidden – started to be ashamed of your lack of story

Accusation – you don't have a story, money, success, clients, fruit

- Agree – Father I agree with this and take it to the cross
- Root – you are an orphan
- Agree – I was adopted

Decrees

- You are my son; nothing can separate us from the love of a Father & Son
- You have learned to follow, do what Father is doing
(you have been weaned from competition, producing, striving)
- You are adopted in the flesh
 - But you have the spirit of adoption in the spirit (Rom 8:15)
 - They are connected in Father's providence (Rom 8:28)
- You will tell many stories of exploits in the future
- You will learn how to tell them

Might – I am the resurrection and the life (Courage)

Living words and deeds from the Council:

- Allow sons to be courageous
- Are the sure foundation for exploits (that work)
- Seeing the reality of *things to come* gives patience and perseverance

Heb 6:10 – *God is not unjust; he will not forget your work and the love you have shown him as you have helped his people and continue to help them.*

11) *We want each of you to show this same diligence to the very end, (telos – completion) so that what you hope for may be fully realized.*

12) *We do not want you to become lazy, but to imitate those **who through faith and patience inherit what has been promised.***

Knowledge – I Am the Way, the Truth, and the Life (Clarity)

- 1) "See" the *things to come* in the Council (develop your seer gift)
- 2) Paint the picture in the story, not just the facts of the truth;
(**the picture of the difference it makes**)
- 3) Contend for your inheritance (faith, patience, exploits)
- 4) Tell the stories, give the praise, celebrate the victories

Fear of the Lord – I Am the vine (Culture)

Culture is built on the stories told in the tribe

- Stories are evidence of God's presence, purpose, and Power
- Stories testify to what is in your book
- Stories are clips from the entire movie
- They point to the climax, the progress
