Father – Yahweh (Father)

"Joint Heirs" – there is usually a team co-laboring, because of awakening

- Look for sons and daughters with a similar call (heirs together)
- Assemble teams under their prophetic banner (Living Words)
- Assemble sons in Father's "House" for Living Words the Council
- **Eph 3:6** This mystery is that through the gospel the Gentiles are heirs together with Israel, members together of one body, and sharers together in the promise in Christ Jesus.
- **Heb 11:9** By faith he made his home in the promised land like a stranger in a foreign country; he lived in tents, as did Isaac and Jacob, who were heirs with him of the same promise.
- 1Pet 3:7 Husbands, in the same way be considerate as you live with your wives, and treat them with respect as the weaker partner and as heirs with you of the gracious gift of life, so that nothing will hinder your prayers.
- **Rom 8:17** Now if we are children (sons), then we are heirs—heirs of God and co-heirs with Christ, if indeed we share in his sufferings in order that we may also share in his glory.
- **Mk 9:28** After Jesus had gone indoors, his disciples asked him privately, "Why couldn't we drive it out?"

29) He replied, "This kind (Lack of Faith) can come out only by prayer."

- Seeking God in the Council (his house) is intentional, awakening, enlivening!
- Bears fruit
 - Living words from heaven
 - Prophetic authority, clarity on earth
- Mt 21:13 My house (the Council) will be called a house of prayer,' but you are making it 'a den of robbers.

House (3634, oikos) Of uncertain affinity; a dwelling (literally or figuratively)

- **Jn 2:17** His disciples remembered that it is written: "Zeal for your house will consume me."
- **Jn 14:2** <mark>My Father's house</mark> has many rooms; if that were not so, would I have told you that I am going there to prepare a place for you?
 - And if I go and prepare a place for you,
 I will come back and take you to be with me that you also may be where I am.
 - 4) You know the way to the place where I am going.
 (Disciples had prayed with Jesus, been to the Council, knew the way)
- **Lu 11:1** Praying in a certain place... Lord, teach us to pray (the "place" is not on earth)
 - Lu 6:12 he went out to a mountain
 - Lu 9:28 Went up on the mountain to pray
 - Lu 22:40 when he can to the place (Mountain)... pray
 - *Mk* 1:35 went to a desolate place, and prayed

Jesus – Immanuel, God with us, Redeemer of (My Story)

Why couldn't we drive it out? (why aren't my prayers answered?)

Mk 9:28 – After Jesus had gone indoors, his disciples asked him privately, "Why couldn't we drive it out?"

- 29) He replied, "This kind (Lack of Faith) can come out only by prayer."
- Lu 10:17 The seventy-two returned with joy and said, "Lord, even the demons submit to us in your name."
 - 20) However, do not rejoice that the spirits submit to you, but rejoice that your names are written in heaven."

Heb 12:22 – But you have come to Mount Zion,
to the city of the living God, the heavenly Jerusalem.
You have come to thousands upon thousands of angels in joyful assembly,
23) to the church of the firstborn, whose names are written in heaven.(Council)
(Sons)

Phil 4:3 – the rest of my co-workers, whose names are in the book of life.

Rom 8:16 – The Spirit himself testifies with our spirit that we are God's children.

- 17) Now if we are children, then we are heirs—heirs of God and co-heirs with Christ, if indeed we share in his sufferings in order that we may also share in his glory.
- **Rom 8:28** And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose.
 - *29)* For those God foreknew he also predestined to be conformed to the image of his Son, that he might be the firstborn among many brothers and sisters.

John, you are redeeming sons

- The firstborn, first-fruits who are in the Council
- Whose names are written because they have been there
- Who bring heaven to earth... in Jesus' name (because they heard the strategy)

That your name is written in heaven

- Is the legal basis for using Jesus' name on earth, hearing Living words in heaven
- That you authority, clarity comes from conversations in the Council

Holy Spirit – I AM the Bread of Life, Spirit of Truth (Purpose)

- 1Cor 11:26 Eat his bread (Purpose)
 - drink this cup (Your cross),
 - → Laying down your life (Mt 16:24-25)
 - ightarrow if indeed we share in his sufferings in order that we may also share in his glory.
- Acts 5:41 The apostles left the Sanhedrin, rejoicing because they had been counted worthy of suffering disgrace for the Name.

John, the life in Living Words is the easy incentive to lay down your life For Father's purpose

The pleasure of sin for a season (dead works) is what competes with transparency, sonship

- Eph 5:5 For of this you can be sure: No immoral, impure or greedy person such a person is an idolater—has any inheritance in the kingdom of Christ and of God.
- 1Cor 6:9 Or do you not know that wrongdoers will not inherit the kingdom of God? Do not be deceived: Neither the sexually immoral nor idolaters nor adulterers nor men who have sex with men
 - nor thieves nor the greedy nor drunkards nor slanderers nor swindlers will inherit the kingdom of God.
- Jn 8:34 Very truly I tell you, everyone who sins is a slave to sin.
 - 35) Now a slave has no permanent place in the family, but a son belongs to it forever.
 - 36) So if the Son sets you free, you will be free indeed.
- **Heb 10:26** If we deliberately keep on sinning after we have received the knowledge of the truth, no sacrifice for sins is left,
- Acts 16:16 Once when we were going to the place of prayer, we were met by a female slave who had a spirit by which she predicted the future. (False prophetic works! Mt 7:22-23) She earned a great deal of money for her owners by fortune-telling.
 - 17) She followed Paul and the rest of us, shouting,"These men are servants of the Most High God, who are telling you the way to be saved."
 - She kept this up for many days.
 Finally, Paul became so annoyed that he turned around and said to the spirit,
 "In the name of Jesus Christ I command you to come out of her!"
 At that moment the spirit left her.

Wisdom – I AM the Light of the world (Strategy)

Lord, show me the nature of sonship, the sons being revealed (Romans 8:19)

1. On the Same Page with Father

- They seek first the Kingdom and His righteousness (Matt 6:33)
- They only do what they see the Father doing (John 5:19)
- Their desires and decisions flow from the Father's heart

2. Present in God's Council

- They participate in the divine conversation (Jer. 23:18)
- They steward and speak living, prophetic words
- Their words carry heaven's authority

3. Free from Dead Works and Fleshly Pursuits

- They serve from identity and clear purpose, not striving and dead works (Heb 6:1)
- They've traded self-promotion for Kingdom assignments, purpose
- Their motives are refined by fire; they aren't afraid of suffering, shame (Rom 8:17)

4. Transparent Before God and Men

- They walk in vulnerability, humility, and light (1 John 1:7)
- No masks, no hiding—authenticity is their covering
- They have nothing to prove and nothing to hide

5. Secure in Their Identity as Sons

- They know they are chosen, loved, and appointed (John 15:16)
- No longer orphans or slaves, but heirs with Christ (Rom. 8:15-17)
- Their confidence flows from their relationship, not performance

6. Carrying the Father's Heart for Nations

- They think generationally and govern with legacy in mind
- They pray, disciple, and build with nations in view (Ps. 2:8)
- They seek transformation beyond personal success
- 7. Instead of a form of godliness that denies the power, Sons have prophetic authority demonstrated in power
 - They heal the sick, cast out demons, and set captives free (Matt. 10:8)
 - They legislate spiritually in the courts, shift atmospheres, and lead prophetically
 - Power is matched with purity and compassion

8. Living From Heaven to Earth


- They operate from seated positions in heavenly places (Eph. 2:6)
- Earth is their assignment, not their source
- They live from rest, not reaction

9. Rooted in Love and Driven by Honor

- Love is their currency and honor is their strategy
- They cover, serve, and empower others without manipulation
- Unity is more than theology-it's relational reality

10. Builders of Kingdom Culture

- They disciple cities, industries, and families with intentionality
- They turn wilderness into gardens and chaos into order (Isa. 58:12)
- They reveal the King by how they do life and business



John, provide the example and the culture to disciple sons

Lord, show me how:

- 1. Engage their hearts in what lies ahead, not their failed past. (Call them into a future purpose written by Father, not shame & accusations from old father.)
- 2. Use the Leader of Living Words, not the letter. (Follow the Holy Spirit, not just the rules—model courage rooted in conversations.)
- 3. Jesus endured the cross and the shame for the joy set before Him. (Live for purpose, not comfort—model sacrificial vision, take up your cross, Mt 16:24-25)
- 4. Live like someone who's already home, not still trying to earn it. (Create safety—model Kingdom family over performance.)
- 5. Let them see what love looks like when it takes responsibility. (Show mature love—model ownership, creativity, faith... not blame.)
- 6. **Invite them to build the culture, not just believe.** (*Model co-laboring—faith that creates, not just intellectual agreement or artificial unity.*)
- 7. **Don't preach sonship—demonstrate it in how you listen, lead, and love.** (*Let people feel the culture of Father through your presence, actions, fruit.*)
- 8. **Be the kind of freedom others want to follow.** (*Model joy and integrity—freedom and flexibility with gravity, unwavering clarity.*)
- 9. Let your confidence come from the words you carry, not how you're received. (Walk in delegated authority—sons show up with Living Words, times of refreshing.)
- 10. Instead of a form of godliness that denies the power, sons have: (prophetic authority in demonstrated power) (grasp the significance of the Name, Lu 10:17) (to heal the sick, raise the dead, cast out demons, and cleanse the lepers)

Understanding – I am the Door (Tactics)

Lord, how to set the bar High? For sonship?

- Without condemnation, judging, or legalism
- Heal people from past or present compromise (Courts)
- Develop transparency, hunger for Kingdom
- Appetite for Council
- 1) People are inspired by your fruit (Humility, forgiveness, failures, trials)
- 2) They learn by doing, experiencing... not theory and preaching

Counsel – I am the good Shepherd (Heritage)

Sons are ultimately motivated to contend for their own heritage

- 1) Help them "see" what that is (their purpose)
- 2) Help them count the cost, grasp the warfare
- 3) hear the strategy and tactics, have the conversations
- 4) John, Make it easy for them to trade
 - a. Missing the mark (sins), iniquity (habitual, deliberate sin)
 - b. For hitting the mark (on the same page with Father)
- **1Pet 4:12** Dear friends, do not be surprised at the fiery ordeal that has come on you to test you, as though something strange were happening to you.
 - 13) But rejoice inasmuch as you participate in the sufferings of Christ, so that you may be overjoyed when his glory is revealed.

Might – I am the resurrection and the life (Courage)

It takes courage to lose your life for Jesus' sake... so that you can find it (it's an awakening!)

"giving your life" to Father's purpose, is what finds your life and sonship

It's a trade that makes sense

- When you see the joy set before you
- The group heritage (those who went before, those who co-labor)
- Have the conversations, hear the specific words

Knowledge – I Am the Way, the Truth, and the Life (Clarity)

John, awakening happens with trades, it's a choice

People who do not accept sonship "yet," are usually carrying baggage they need to trade:

- Trade deception for truth (Baggage Symptoms: hunger, hearing, understanding, resistance)
- Trade iniquity for being on Father's page (righteousness)
- Trade sin (missing the mark) for doing what Father is doing
- Trade dead works for Living Words and deeds; put Kingdom first (Jesus is the way, the truth, and the life (Jn 14:6), the Word (Jn 1:1, 14))

Jn 7:17 – Anyone who chooses to do the will of God will find out whether my teaching comes from God or whether I speak on my own.

18) Whoever speaks on their own does so to gain personal glory, but he who seeks the glory of the one who sent him is a man of truth; there is nothing false about him. (Authenticity)

Jn 8:31 – If you hold to my teaching, you are really my disciples.

- 32) Then you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free."
- 34) Jesus replied, "Very truly I tell you, everyone who sins is a slave to sin.
- 35) a slave has no permanent place in the family, but a son belongs to it forever.
- Mt 13:11 Because the knowledge of the secrets of the kingdom of heaven has been given to you, but not to them.
 - 12) Whoever has will be given more, and they will have an abundance. Whoever does not have, even what they have will be taken from them.
 - 13) This is why I speak to them in parables:"Though seeing, they do not see; though hearing, they do not hear or understand.
 - 14) In them is fulfilled the prophecy of Isaiah:You will be ever hearing but never understanding;you will be ever seeing but never perceiving.

Fear of the Lord – I Am the vine (Culture)

Tell the stories of what you traded to awaken

- 1) What lies you let go of, and why?
- 2) What dead works did you abandon? What replaced them?
- 3) Tell the stories of how you received Living Words; contrast them with dead words.
- Jn 7:18 Authenticity Whoever speaks on their own does so to gain personal glory, but he who seeks the glory of the one who sent him is a man of truth; there is nothing false about him.
- **Jn 8:43** Why is my language not clear to you? Because you are unable to hear what I say.
 - 44) <u>You belong to your father</u>, the devil, and you want to carry out your father's desires. He was a murderer from the beginning, not holding to the truth, for there is no truth in him. When he lies, he speaks his native language, for he is a liar and the father of lies.
- Jn 16:13 But when he, the Spirit of truth, comes, he will guide you into all the truth. He will not speak on his own; he will speak only what he hears, and he will tell you what is yet to come.

10 Reasons People's Beliefs Are Unchanged by Facts

- Beliefs Are Rooted in Identity, Not Information

 Facts that contradict who someone *thinks they are* feel like a threat, not a help.
- They Trust Emotion Over Evidence

 What *feels true* often outweighs what *is true*, especially when past wounds are involved.
- They've Made an Idol of Their Experience

 "If I haven't seen it or felt it, it can't be real." Personal history becomes their doctrine.
- 4. Fear of Change Feels Safer Than the Cost of Growth

 Changing beliefs often means changing behavior, which is uncomfortable and uncertain.
- 5. Their Community Reinforces the Old Belief
 People will stay loyal to tribe over truth to avoid rejection or conflict.
- 6. **They Interpret New Facts Through Old Filters** – Even truth is twisted when run through the lens of past pain, religion, or orphan thinking.
- 7. They Don't Feel Understood, Only Corrected

 Without empathy and connection, truth sounds like criticism, not invitation.
- 8. They've Confused Faithfulness with Stubbornness

 "Standing firm" can be a cover for refusing to reevaluate what God is actually saying now.
- The Facts Don't Fit Their Narrative of God
 A wrong view of the Father can block even biblically sound truth from taking root.
- 10. They've Built a Life Around the Lie

 Letting go of a belief would unravel a marriage, a ministry, a mindset—they've built on sand, and they know it.

10 Reasons People Awaken Spiritually and Change Naturally

1. They Experience the Father's Love Personally

One moment of real love melts years of striving, shame, or unbelief.
Love awakens identity—transformation follows.

2. They Encounter Truth That Resonates with Their Spirit

When truth bypasses logic and touches the heart, it *feels like home*.
Revelation brings rest, not resistance.

- 3. They See a Living Example Worth Following

 A son living in freedom, joy, and authority makes people hungry for more.
 Culture trumps argument.
- They Get Tired of the Pain of Staying Stuck

 Pain becomes a teacher when it reveals what's not working.

- Suffering softens pride and opens the door to new answers.

- 5. They Hear the Voice of God for Themselves
 - One whisper from Father is worth more than a thousand sermons.
 - Hearing Him activates identity and direction.

6. They Feel Safe to Be Honest

- When shame is removed and vulnerability is modeled, people open up.

- Healing begins when hiding ends.

7. They Realize They're Chosen, Not Just Forgiven

- Salvation moves from a legal transaction to a relational calling.

- Chosen people think and act differently.

8. They Find Purpose Bigger Than Themselves

- Vision ignites desire, and desire fuels discipline.
- Purpose pulls them forward more than pressure ever could.

9. They Let Go of the Lie That God Is Disappointed

When they realize Father is *for* them, not *against* them, they relax and receive.
Grace gives permission to grow.

10. They Join a Kingdom Culture That Supports Their Growth

- Community normalizes what once seemed impossible.
- Belief becomes lifestyle when it's shared and celebrated.
