A Kingdom Business Assessment

This questionnaire will help you identify whether you're living on "crumbs" or having actual conversations with Father in His Council. Answer honestly—this is your journey from self-sufficiency to sonship.

Part 1: The Mask of Self-Sufficiency

Scoring Guide

Self-Sufficiency Level (Questions 1-3): If you're wearing masks and struggling with fragility, you're ready for the transition to authentic sonship.

Crumbs vs. Conversations (Questions 4-9): Count how many "substitutes" you checked in question 9. The more you rely on substitutes, the more you're living on crumbs rather than conversations.

Sonship Readiness (Questions 10-16): If you resonate with the Caleb personality and are experiencing Father's love surpassing your self-sufficiency, you're in the transition to sonship.

Council Access (Questions 13-16, 18): Your scores reveal whether you're accessing Father's Council or operating from formulas and advice.

Current State (Questions 17, 21, 23): These questions show where you are on the journey from servant/self-sufficiency to son/co-laboring.
